# Your benefits

## **Tuition-free master's degrees**

Master's students receive financial support amounting to 934 euros per month to cover their living costs. The courses are tuition-free. Through consecutive master's and PhD funding, it is possible for the best candidates to seamlessly transition to a fully funded PhD programme.

## **Fixed research position with salary**

PhD students are employed for three years. They are paid according to the TV-L E13 salary scale, which includes social benefits and mobility grants for home visits, as well as travel costs for relocation and attending conferences. The master's and PhD programmes are both conducted in English.

## **Mentorship by experts**

The outstanding, research-driven education is complemented by mentorship provided by experts in an interdisciplinary and cross-locational network within the AI ecosystem in Germany, with a special focus on state-of-the-art AI technology. The opportunity to undertake an internship adds an extra industry-centric viewpoint to the Zuse Schools, enriching the career trajectories of budding AI researchers.
